

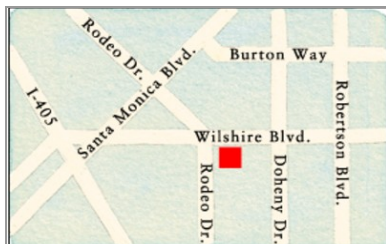

A landmark since it opened in 1928, Beverly Wilshire in Beverly Hills (A Four Seasons Hotel), has consistently been a preferred address for Hollywood's A-list and discerning international travellers. At the prestigious intersection of Rodeo Drive and Wilshire Boulevard, the Hotel offers a walkable downtown Beverly Hills location – with designer shopping right outside the door.

Fully revitalised, the Hotel features 395 fresh, contemporary guest rooms, including 137 spacious suites. Destination dining makes Beverly Wilshire a popular gathering place, with CUT, an innovative steakhouse by Wolfgang Puck, and The Blvd, for creative dining, cocktails and sidewalk-café people-watching. For events, over 25,000 square feet (2,300 square metres) of glamorous function space includes seven meeting rooms and two grand ballrooms. For quiet relaxation, there's the sleek, stylish Spa and the Mediterranean-inspired swimming pool.

With its coveted location, Beverly Wilshire offers an urban resort-style destination where

exceptional Four Seasons cuisine, recreation and service present the best that Beverly Hills has to offer.

TRANSPORTATION

DESTINATION

The west-coast capital of business and entertainment, Los Angeles is known as the City of Angels. Originally a sleepy little town, Los Angeles grew slowly until the discovery of oil at the close of the 1800s. But it was the silver-screen era that turned Los Angeles into a boomtown – with the idyllic Southern California climate allowing filming to take place outdoors all year round.

The exclusive community of Beverly Hills is midway between downtown Los Angeles and Pacific Ocean beaches. Simultaneously a small town and a highly sophisticated city, Beverly Hills is a glamorous, trend-setting destination for shopping and dining that is also a quietly elegant residential enclave favoured by Hollywood's elite.

Downtown Beverly Hills is a traditional city centre featuring lively, pedestrian-friendly streets. At its heart is world-famous Rodeo Drive – a dazzling streetscape lined with designer fashion boutiques and glittering jewellery shops. At the top of Rodeo Drive stands the landmark Beverly Wilshire in Beverly Hills (A Four Seasons Hotel).

WEATHER

Sunny Los Angeles offers comfortable temperatures throughout the year. Offshore breezes keep the coast cooler in August and September, while city-centre temperatures reach close to the mid-80s°F (30°C). Winter temperatures, 65°F (18°C) on average, are cooler in the early morning and warmer by mid-day.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS AND ACTIVITIES

At Beverly Wilshire, you enjoy a unique vantage point from which to explore the sights, sounds and experiences around you. We hope the highlights of local Beverly Hills and Los Angeles attractions below help simplify your planning. Popular attractions include shopping on Rodeo Drive, Universal Studios Hollywood, LA Lakers or Clippers basketball, The Getty Center, Disneyland and much more. Within a few minutes walk of the Hotel

Rodeo Drive:

- Located at the famous intersection of Rodeo Drive and Wilshire Boulevard, Beverly Wilshire in Beverly Hills (A Four Seasons Hotel) is just steps away from this exciting upscale shopping area.

Beverly Hills Trolley Tour:

- Enjoy a 40-minute tour of art and architecture through historical and renowned areas of Beverly Hills, including Rodeo Drive. Beverly Hills Trolley Tour hours are seasonal and generally operate five days a week in the summer and only on Saturdays during the remainder of the year. Privately guided tours are available. For advance reservations, please contact the Concierge.

Within a 5-minute walk of the Hotel

The Paley Center for Media:

- At its new Beverly Hills location, the Paley Center for Media offers a complete history of radio and television.

Within a 10-minute drive of the Hotel

Los Angeles County Museum of Art:

- The grande dame of Los Angeles's Museum Row is the Los Angeles County Museum of Art. More than 150,000 works from around the world are featured in the museum's permanent collection, including paintings, drawings, prints and sculptures by masters such as Rembrandt, Monet and Matisse. Major exhibitions of ancient Roman artworks, bronze sculptures from southeast Asia, 16th-century textiles, decorative arts and photography attract 600,000 visitors each year. The museum hosts more than 30 special shows annually; recent exhibitions focused on Picasso, Chagall, David Hockney and Frank Lloyd Wright.

Museum of Tolerance:

- The Museum focuses on issues of *intolerance*, from domestic civil rights to worldwide prejudice. It features artefacts from Auschwitz and personal items once belonging to Anne Frank; photographs and video testimonies by Holocaust survivors are particularly hard-hitting.

Petersen Automotive Museum:

- Recognised internationally for its innovative design, is dedicated to the interpretive study of the automobile and its influence on our life and culture. Encompassing more than 300,000 square feet (28,000 square metres), its exhibits and lifelike dioramas feature more than 150 rare and classic cars, trucks and motorcycles.

Shopping Centres:

- There are a number of shopping centres just minutes from the Hotel, including the Beverly Center, Westfield Century City and the Grove, featuring stores such as Bloomingdale's, Barneys New York, Neiman Marcus and Saks Fifth Avenue.

Greystone Mansion and Park:

- The romantic setting of this 18.5-acre (7.5-hectare) park serves as a location for cultural activities, a quiet getaway for daily visitors and a memorable backdrop for weddings and other celebrations. The mansion, featured in many films, photography and advertising, is accessible by the public for musical and theatrical performances.

Within a 15-minute drive of the Hotel

UCLA Hammer Museum:

- The Museum features paintings by old masters, Impressionists and Post-impressionists, including masterpieces by Rembrandt, Cassat, Monet and van Gogh. The UCLA Grunwald Center for the Graphic Arts, which is also part of the museum, includes prints, drawings, photographs and artists' books from the Renaissance to the present.

Grauman's Chinese Theatre:

- Hollywood comes alive as visitors stroll the Walk of Fame, which commemorates celebrities whose names appear on bronze stars on the sidewalk, or compare footprints

of the stars in the courtyard of Grauman's Chinese Theatre.

Within a 20-minute drive of the Hotel

Walt Disney Concert Hall:

- The fourth and most recent addition to the Music Center of Los Angeles County. Designed by the internationally renowned architect Frank Gehry, the 293,000 square-foot (27,220 square-metre) Concert Hall features a wavy steel exterior designed to resemble a ship with its sail in full mast, representing Gehry's wish to create the feeling of travelling along a ceremonial barge to music. The centrepiece of the Concert Hall, a 2,265-seat auditorium with natural lighting in which the audience surrounds the orchestra, was designed to look and feel like the ship's hull.

Hollywood Bowl:

- The summer home of the Los Angeles Philharmonic and also hosts outdoor concerts by top classical, popular and jazz artists.

Pantages Theatre:

- An old Hollywood theatre featuring Broadway and off-Broadway plays and musicals.

Hollywood & Highland/Kodak Theatre:

- As the new epicentre of pop culture, Hollywood and Highland represents the dramatic revitalisation of the entertainment, fine dining, shopping, tourism and history that have defined the world's movie-making capital for almost a century. With 640,000 square feet (60,000 square metres) of one-of-a-kind shops, restaurants, broadcasting facilities and cinemas - plus the world's only live broadcast performing arts theatre and new home of the Academy Awards presentations - this spectacular destination pays homage to the movie industry's illustrious past and hails the new glory days of Hollywood.

Within a 30-minute drive of the Hotel

Universal Studios Hollywood:

- Movie lovers will be thrilled to experience a host of rides, shows and attractions that bring their favourite films to life. Then, go deep behind the scenes where today's hottest movies are being made, to see the sets and secrets revealed – so close you can hear the cameras rolling, and maybe catch a glimpse of a star.

The Getty Center:

- The stunning architecture by Richard Meier and its hilltop site allows for breathtaking city vistas. Paintings, decorative arts, photographs, manuscripts and drawings are divided among five galleries. You can see works by Rembrandt, Monet, Cézanne, Leonardo da Vinci and Michelangelo; van Gogh's *Irises* is the top draw. Robert Irwin's Central Garden offers an intriguing place to rest.

Natural History Museum of Los Angeles County:

- Children and adults alike will be awed by the wonders at the Natural History Museum of Los Angeles County. Only surpassed in size by the Smithsonian Institution and the American Museum of Natural History, the museum's collection includes 16 million specimens and artefacts. Highlights include dinosaur skeletons and more than 2,000

gems and minerals.

Third Street Promenade:

- Located in Santa Monica, the Promenade has shops, movies and restaurants.

Skirball Cultural Center:

- Celebrating the Jewish-American experience through a range of programmes, the Center is doubling its size - a new hall and museum space will make it the largest Jewish cultural centre in North America. The galleries have also been redesigned.

Santa Monica and Malibu Beaches:

- Two popular beaches are at Santa Monica and Malibu. Other outdoor activities in the area include horseback riding in Griffith Park and hiking on Mount Wilson.

VIP Backlot Tours:

- Fabled motion picture studios such as NBC, Universal and Warner Brothers offer a chance to see behind the scenes in VIP backlot tours.

Within a 1-hour drive of the Hotel

Disneyland:

- World-famous Disneyland features dining, shopping, entertainment and more than 55 adventures and attractions in seven magical theme lands. Mickey Mouse's theme park offers a magical experience for the entire family.

CONFERENCE FACILITIES

An ideal setting for gatherings of all kinds, Beverly Wilshire accommodates meetings and galas for more than 800 people. Encompassing over 25,000 square feet (2,300 square metres) of versatile function space, the Hotel's two high-tech ballrooms and seven intimate function spaces provide a memorable backdrop for events.

The two-level Grand Ballroom features a formal stage and a large permanent dance floor. The abstract oceanic carpet is the highlight of the room, creating style from the bottom up. Matching the ocean curves are large Italian-crystal chandeliers and wall sconces. With convenient ground-floor access, the Ballroom is approached through a traditional loggia and private reception area. On the Ballroom's upper level, the Wintergarden is perfect for hosting pre-event receptions. The second ballroom, Le Grand Trianon, features a large sunken dance floor and an elegant built-in stage with a trompe l'oeil mural of gardens.

GUEST ROOMS, SUITES AND PRIVATE RESIDENCES OVERVIEW

Beverly Wilshire presents 395 fresh, contemporary five-star guest rooms, including 137 luxury suites on Beverly Hills' Wilshire Boulevard. Some accommodations open onto furnished balconies, and many showcase spectacular views of Rodeo Drive, the Hollywood Hills and the Los Angeles skyline.

Guest rooms and suites are located in two wings: the 10-storey Wilshire Wing is the original building at the corner of Wilshire and Rodeo, while the 14-storey Beverly Wing is more contemporary and looks across Beverly Hills and Los Angeles. The side-by-side buildings are connected by a beautifully designed central porte cochère. The interior design of accommodations in both wings is similar, offering contemporary décor with soft cream tones for a light, airy appeal.

All luxury accommodations feature well-defined work areas with an executive writing desk, allowing focused productivity. Each room offers multi-line telephones with voice mail, wired and wireless high-speed Internet access and a 42-inch (106-centimetre) plasma television, including DVD player.

Sleek, spacious and thoughtfully detailed, the Italian marble bathrooms include a deep soaking tub and a separate glass-walled shower. Superior-quality towels and toiletries are refreshed by twice-daily housekeeping.

Guest Room Overview

With exceptional variety and individual charm, Beverly Wilshire guest rooms are ideal for both business and leisure travellers. In the Beverly Wing, spacious Signature Rooms overlook the Hotel's beautiful Mediterranean-style pool or its elaborate porte cochère. On higher floors of the Beverly Wing, Signature Balcony Rooms feature pool or porte cochère views, and a furnished balcony. Predominantly in the Wilshire Wing, BW Studios combine a spacious sitting/sleeping area and feature views of the pool and Rodeo Drive.

Suites Overview

Perfect for longer stays, for families or for special celebrations, suites at Beverly Wilshire feature sitting and sleeping rooms separated by solid wood doors – adding privacy for business, entertaining or interviews. The opulent One-Bedroom Suites Wilshire Wing showcase stunning views of Rodeo Drive or El Camino Drive. Corner Beverly Suites are corner suites showcasing spectacular city views from a wraparound balcony, and include a guest powder room off the living room. Rodeo Suites offer two full Italian marble bathrooms; the master bathroom includes a night desk and a vanity.

The unique studio-style Veranda Suite features a private marble and wrought iron stairway entrance and is located on its own private floor on the highest level of the Wilshire Wing (the 10th floor). A garden terrace, accessible by stairs only, offers stunning views of Rodeo Drive and the Hollywood Hills.

Three expansive one-of-a-kind suites are located on the privately accessed 14th floor of the Beverly Wing, commanding views of Beverly Hills and Century City from furnished balconies. Elegantly appointed, the one-bedroom Ambassador Suite provides a modern residential setting, featuring a dining area, a luxurious master bedroom with canopy bed and a plasma television in the master bathroom. The residential-style two-bedroom Governor Suite offers a very spacious living room with a 50-inch (127-centimetre) plasma television and a dining area for six, supported by kitchen facilities.

The extravagant two-bedroom Presidential Suite in the Wilshire Wing is beautifully appointed and designed to resemble a Park Avenue penthouse, with Roman columns, high ceilings and antiques throughout. The grand skylit entrance foyer leads to a comfortable den, large living room, separate library and elegant dining room.

Beautifully positioned on the private 14th floor of the Beverly Wing, the three-bedroom Penthouse Suite offers 270-degree city views from its floor-to-ceiling windows and wraparound balcony. The living room and den are adjoined by a dining area seating 12. The master bathroom features a deep soaking whirlpool tub, as well as his-and-hers showers with picture windows overlooking the city.
