An intimate retreat on the banks of the Rio de la Plata, Four Seasons Resort Carmelo, Uruguay, is surrounded by a fragrant sea of pine and eucalyptus trees. Championship golf, an Asian-influenced spa, secluded beach terraces, a large outdoor pool and a wide range of recreational activities make it a perfect base for exploring a fascinating area.

With 20 bungalows and 44 bi-level suites, two restaurants, a lobby lounge and meeting space that is perfect for small high-level business meetings, the Resort is an exceptional getaway retreat. The serenity of its surroundings, together with the Resort's unique blend of Asian harmony, South American verve and warm and intuitive service 24 hours a day, guarantees guests complete comfort and pleasure.

TRANSPORTATION

From Ezeiza International Airport in Buenos Aires, it is a 3-hour car and ferry ride or a

30-minute flight via small plane to Four Seasons Resort Carmelo.

The airport is served by a number of international airlines, including Aerolineas Argentinas, Air Canada, Air Europa, Air France, Alitalia, American Airlines, Avianca, British Airways, Continental Airlines, Copa Airlines, Cubana de Aviacion, Delta Airlines, Iberia Airlines, KLM Royal Dutch Airlines, LADE, Lan Chile, Lan Peru, Lufthansa, Malaysia Airlines, Mexicana, Qantas, PLUNA, South African Airways, Swiss International Air Lines, TACA, TAM, United Airlines, and VARIG.

Montevideo airport in Uruguay is 285 kilometres (177 miles) from Four Seasons Resort Carmelo, approximately a 4-hour drive. The airport is served by: Aerolineas Argentinas, American Airlines, Lloyd Aero Boliviano, United Airlines, and VARIG.

DESTINATION

A land of rolling hills and vast fertile grassy plains, Uruguay is one of the most intriguing countries in South America. Alive with the spirit of the gaucho – the region's colourful cowboy – its mild and sunny climate offers year-round appeal. Positioned in the southwest, a four-hour drive from Montevideo, Four Seasons sits adjacent to pristine woodland on the banks of the Rio de la Plata, one of the world's widest rivers. Explorations extend from the nearby quiet farming village of Carmelo to the charming town of Colonia, a UNESCO World Heritage site just one hour away, to tours of local wineries, exploring the Uruguayan countryside on horseback or observing the enormous variety of birds that frequent this gloriously unspoiled region.

Combining a journey of discovery with the rejuvenating ease of a Four Seasons vacation, Four Seasons Resort Carmelo, Uruguay provides ample opportunities to experience an exceptional getaway.

WEATHER

The seasons are clearly distinguished in Carmelo. In winter (June to August), the temperatures do not usually go below 0° C, maintaining an average of 8-10° C. In the summer months (December to February), the temperature is rarely higher than 32° C. In spring (September to November) and fall (March to May), the temperature maintains a comfortable average between 18° C and 20° C.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS AND ACTIVITIES

At Four Seasons, you enjoy a unique vantage point from which to explore the sights, sounds and experiences around you. We hope the highlights of local attractions below help simplify your planning. Please let us know how else we can assist you.

Within a 10-minute drive of the Resort

City of Carmelo:

- Founded by Coronel José Gervasio Artigas on February 12, 1816, Carmelo is just 6 kilometres (4 miles) from the Resort. Carmelo is an authentic South American town (population 22,000) that has yet to be touched by commercialism. In the South American summer, many Argentinians dock their boats in this riverside town. It is known for its collection of cars from the 1920s and 1930s, which have been refurbished and can be seen throughout the area.

San Roque's Chapel:

- This little church was founded December 1, 1869, and consecrated August 16, 1870. Since then, each year the church has held a celebration in honour of San Roque, the patron saint of those who are ill.

Within a 15-minute drive of the Resort

Local Wineries:

- Uruguayan wineries produce about 800,000 bottles of wine each year. The wineries feature Tannat, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon and Mistela grapes, as well as some sparkling wines. The wine is exported to France, Italy and Germany.

Three wineries are within a 20-kilometre (12-mile) radius of the Resort. The local

winery and the largest in the area is Irurtia. Located just 15 minutes from the Resort, Irurtia offers tastings of a variety of wines, including Chardonnay, Tannat and Botrytis, a dessert wine.

Within a 1-hour drive of the Resort

Colonia:

- Colonia (population 30,000) is a lovely historic city. Founded by the Portuguese in 1680 on the tip of a peninsula on the Río de la Plata estuary, it is now a UNESCO World Heritage site. Colonia's cobblestone streets are reminiscent of old Lisbon, lined with small museums, tiny bars, fine restaurants and arts and crafts shops.

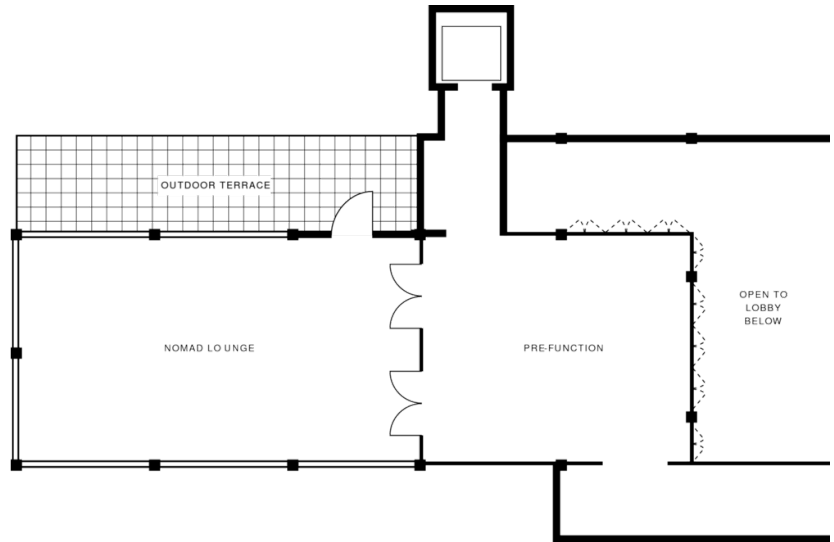

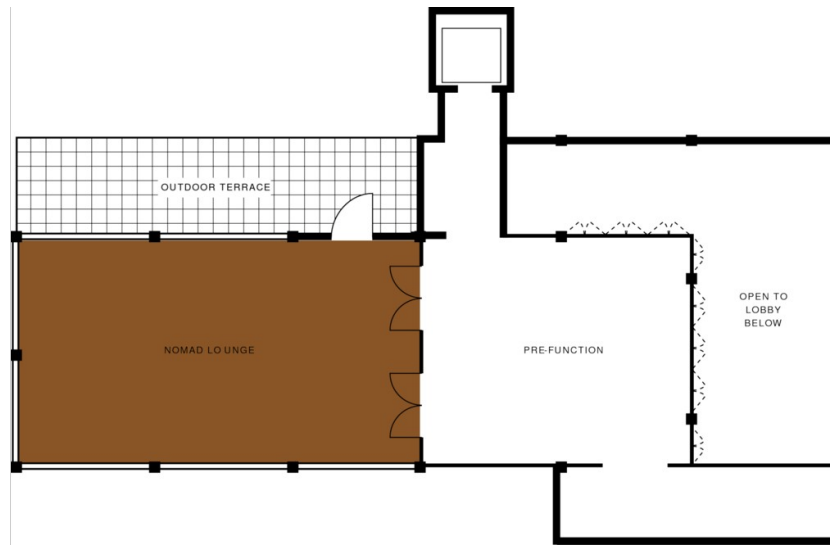

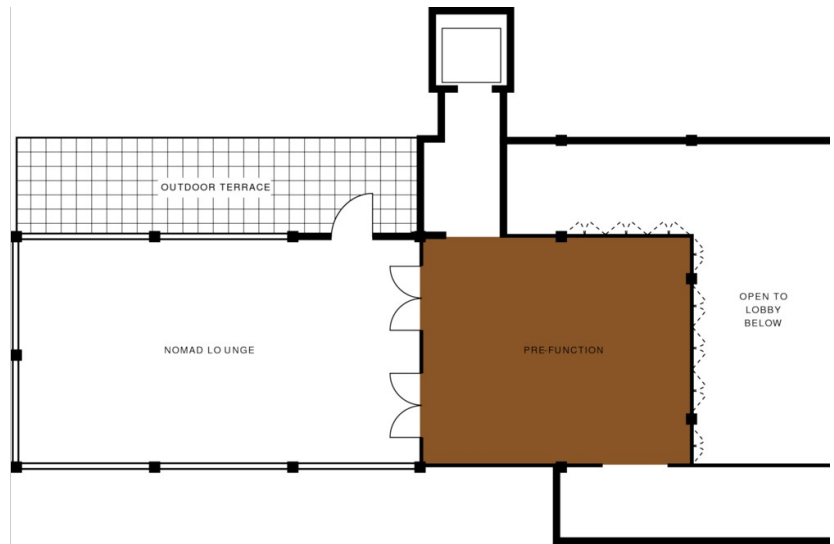

GUEST ROOMS, SUITES AND PRIVATE RESIDENCES OVERVIEW

Nestled within a scented forest, Four Seasons offers 20 bungalows – including six overlooking the river – and 44 bi-level suites. Each accommodation exudes a cosy ambience, with polished, hand-finished floors and open-beamed ceilings with ceiling fans. All have private terraces that are perfect for outdoor living and dining.

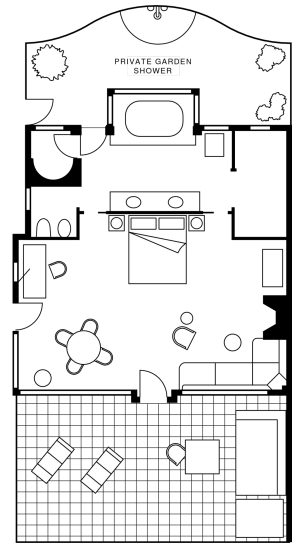
Suites Overview

Airy and spacious, the Bi-level Suites offer extra privacy, lofty comfort and panoramic vistas. 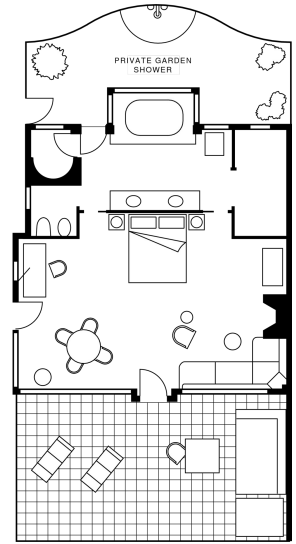

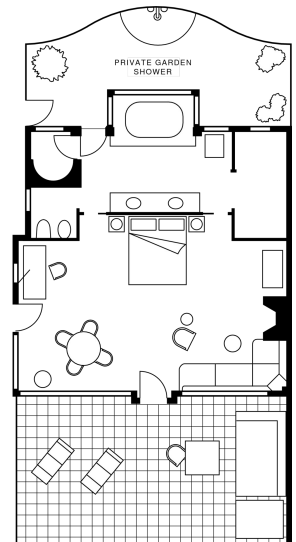

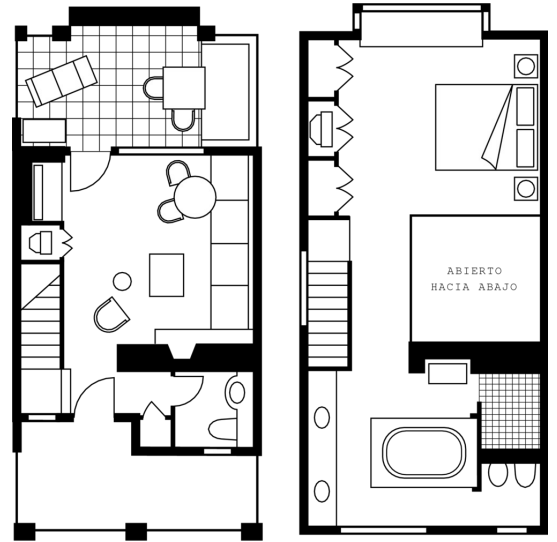

Four Seasons offers tempting options that reflect the Resort's East-meets-West sensibility. Pura, with its Balinese décor, offers typical Uruguayan cuisine; Mandara, with its Moroccan/Balinese ambience and enticing views, serves a wide selection of local meats. One of two lounges, Shiva Lounge offers an upstairs Library, a relaxing enclave for reading or surfing the Internet. For small groups, private dining can be arranged in the Gazebo.

RESTAURANTS

Pura

Pura, which means "temple," is the Resort's all-day dining restaurant, enticing guests with batik draperies and carved panels depicting mythical Balinese figures.

The restaurant's focal point is a glass mosaic pool from which a Balinese spirit house rises. The floor is white crystalline granite and blue Brazilian marble. Private dining behind batik drapery is available in three corners of the restaurant. Corner chandeliers lit with candles can be raised or lowered according to guests' preferences.
