Hugging the southwestern shores of Lake Geneva, Switzerland's second-largest city is spectacularly located between the Jura Mountains and the Alps, within view of Mont Blanc. Renowned for its elegance and sophistication, Geneva provides a legendary setting for Four Seasons Hotel des Bergues Geneva.



Rising beside Lake Geneva, at its junction with the Rhône, the Hotel des Bergues is Geneva's oldest luxury hotel. Founded in 1834, it epitomises neo-classical Belle Époque architecture. The designated Swiss heritage building has hosted world statesmen, royalty and celebrities throughout its illustrious history. Reborn after a sparkling renaissance as a Four Seasons Hotel, it thoughtfully blends impeccably modern amenities and timeless elegance. Offering 103 residential-style guest rooms and suites overlooking captivating views, lakefront dining, indulgent spa services and a distinctive venue for business and social occasions, Four Seasons is a magnificent base – superbly located on the Quai des Bergues, just steps from the financial district and the best shopping in the city.

TRANSPORTATION

Geneva Cointrin International Airport is 4.5 kilometres (2.8 miles) and approximately 15 minutes by car from the Hotel. It is served by most major international airlines. Rental

cars can be arranged at the airport, as well as through the Hotel's Concierge. The Hotel is also a 10-minute walk or a short drive from Gare Cornavin, the city's main train station. Valet parking and a limousine service are available at the Hotel; please enquire with the Concierge for details.

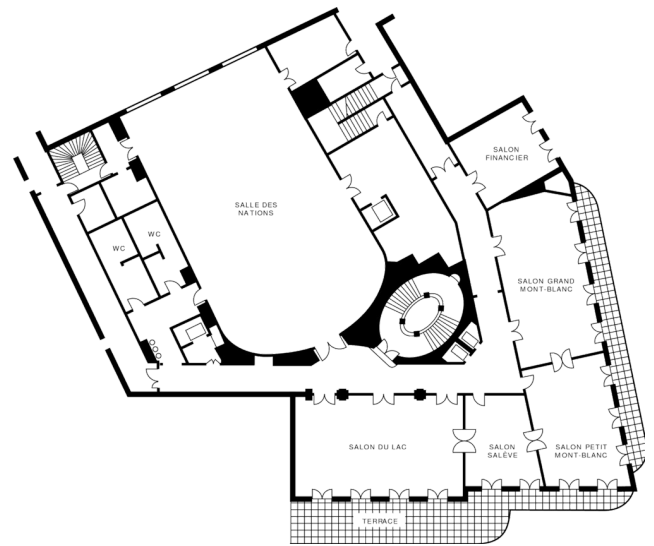

CONFERENCE FACILITIES

With a ballroom specially created to host the first meeting of the League of Nations in 1920, Four Seasons combines the grandeur of its historic setting with ultramodern technology. The Hotel is able to accommodate up to 300 guests for a wide variety of functions – from high-powered board meetings to gala dinners and weddings.

Offering 595 square metres (6,405 square feet) of flexible space – from the Salle des Nations with its sparkling chandeliers, soaring ceilings, huge gilt mirrors and enchanting courtyard views to five connecting salons, all bathed in natural daylight from lofty windows – the choice ranges from magnificent to intimate. All five of the smaller salons lead onto a secluded outdoor terrace that overlooks Lake Geneva and the Rhône.

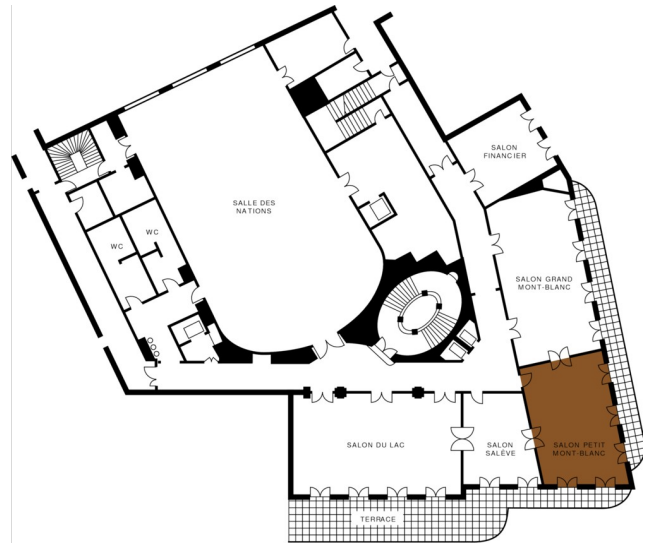


SALON PETIT MONT-BLANC

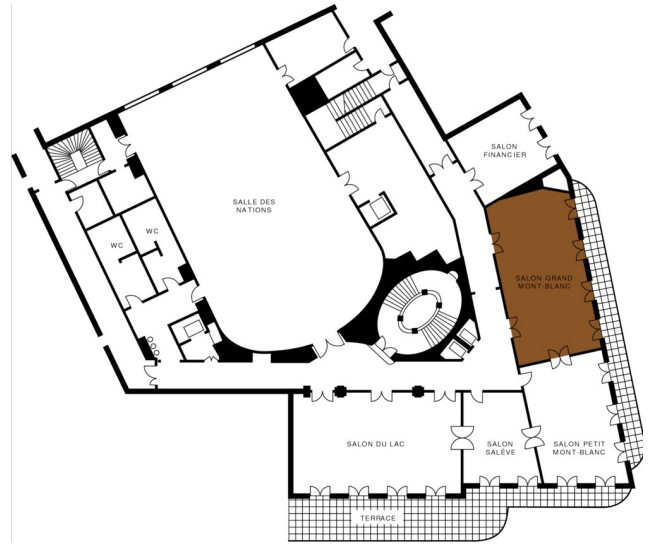


SALON GRAND MONT-BLANC

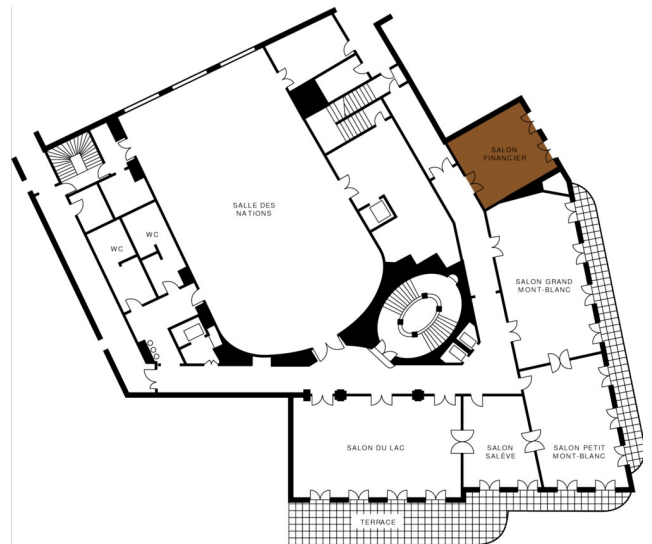

GUEST ROOMS, SUITES AND PRIVATE RESIDENCES OVERVIEW

Guided by renowned interior designer Pierre-Yves Rochon, the 115 guest rooms and suites are richly elegant, combining the Hotel's classical elegance and style with the latest in technology. With enchanting views of the lake, the Old Town or the courtyard, all accommodations are bright and airy, decorated with rich blue and green fabrics, light woods and Louis Philippe-style furnishings. Nearly a quarter of the rooms are spacious suites – most with step-out balconies and views of Lake Geneva.

All rooms include two direct-dial, dual-line telephones with voicemail, high-speed wired and wireless Internet access, DVD players and LCD flat-screen televisions. Deluxe marble bathrooms feature deep-soaking tubs and complimentary toiletries, a large vanity, steam-resistant mirrors and a heated towel rack; most have a WC with dual-line telephone in a separate alcove.

Four Seasons Hotel des Bergues Geneva offers a distinctive selection of unique suites. Bergues One-Bedroom Suites feature an exceptionally spacious bedroom with a loveseat in the cosy sitting area. Suites Léman offer extra high ceilings, large windows overlooking Lake Geneva and a guest powder room adjoining the living area. Suites Mont Blanc are corner suites with gorgeous views.

The one-bedroom Presidential Suite offers lake views from floor-to-ceiling windows, an expansive living room and dining for up to six. The lavish Rousseau Suite features a comfortable living room with sofa and lounge chairs, a dining area, an office and numerous windows overlooking the city and Lake Geneva. Embodying absolute opulence, the Royal Suite is a one-of-a-kind two-bedroom suite – with a private terrace overlooking the city and Lake Geneva, a lavish salon with a marble fireplace, a large foyer, a formal dining room for eight and an adjoining pantry.

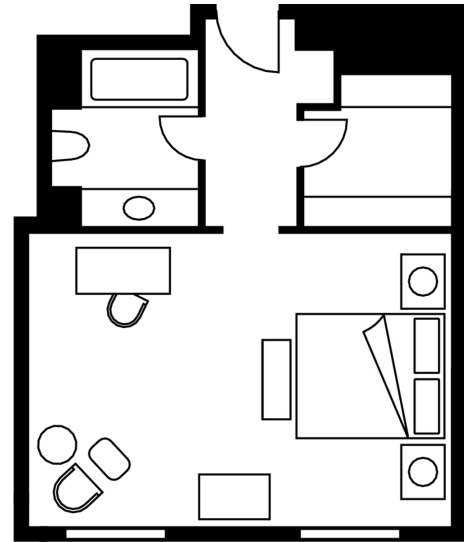

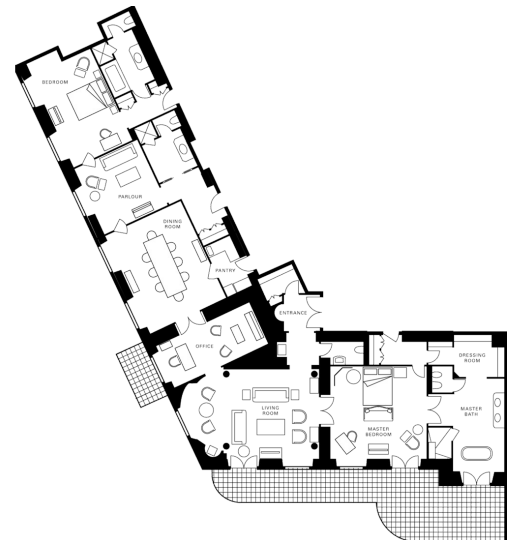

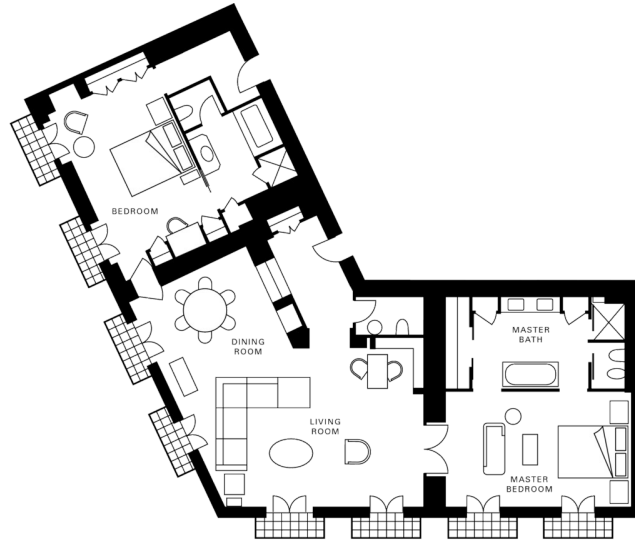

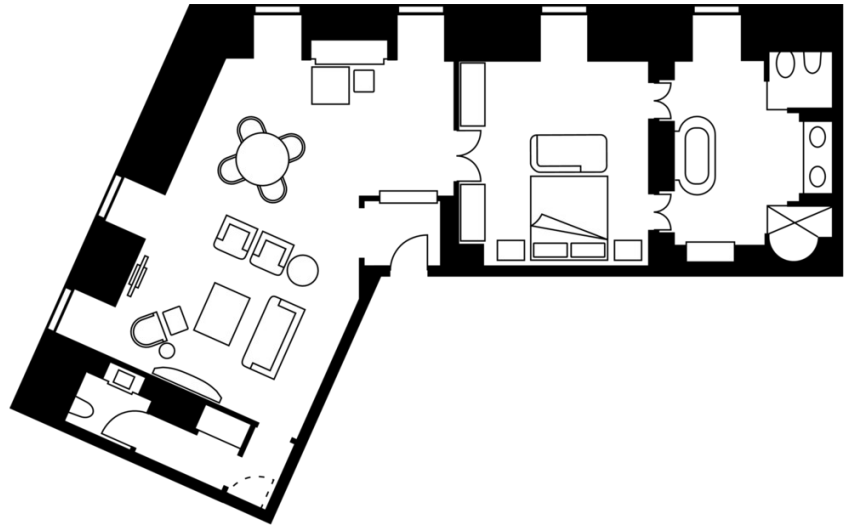

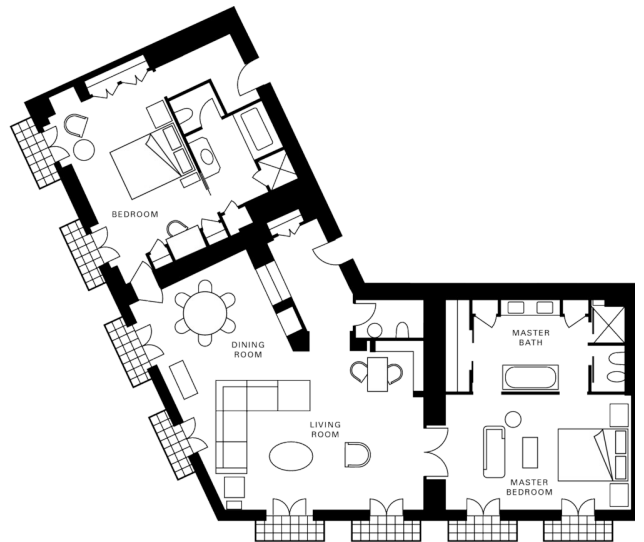

Domaine de Divonne

Across the border in France, at the Domaine de Divonne, is one of Europe's finest and most spectacular 18-hole championship golf courses.

Hiking and skiing

Geneva is perfectly situated for skiing in the winter or alpine hikes in the warmer months. The closest place to ski, Mégève, in France, is only a 75 minute drive from Geneva. Chamonix, at the foot of Mont Blanc, is an hour away from Geneva. Mont Blanc, at 4,807 metres (15,770 feet) and the crown jewel of the French Alps and Europe's highest mountain, is also a pleasant drive from the Hotel. Other nearby mountains in France's Haute Savoie region include Les Voirons, Le Môle and Le Salève.

From April to October, the summit of Le Salève can be reached via a 15-minute tram ride from downtown Geneva, followed by a three-minute ascent in a cable car. Hikers enjoy incomparable views - Geneva, the distant Jura Mountains to the north, and the Alps and Mont Blanc to the south.

Water sports

Sailing is the most popular sport in Geneva, and there are plenty of opportunities for waterskiing as well.
