DESTINATION

Mexico City is the focus of Mexico's political, cultural and economic life. The nation's capital and its largest metropolis, it has a population of over 25 million and covers an area of 1,547 square kilometres (597 square miles). Its wide boulevards are lined by both modern glass and steel structures and the colonial architecture of the past.

With its diverse heritage, the city offers 75 museums and 10 archaeological zones. Mexico City's historical centre is a 668-block area around the Zócalo (main square) that has been designated a World Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO. The district encompasses more than 1,400 historic structures, including the Templo Mayor (Great Temple of the Aztecs), as well as private mansions and civic and religious buildings.

WEATHER

In its valley setting, Mexico City offers a temperate climate with cooler temperatures than coastal regions. The city enjoys warm weather, year round. Winter temperatures, chilly at dawn and dusk, are reminiscent of spring.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS AND ACTIVITIES

At Four Seasons Hotel México, D.F., you enjoy a unique vantage point from which to explore the sights, sounds and experiences around you. We hope the highlights of local attractions below help simplify the planning for your next Mexico City hotel experience. Please let us know how else we can assist you.

Within a 5-minute walk of the Hotel

Bosque de Chapultepec (Chapultepec Park):

- The oldest natural park in North America, Chapultepec Park is the largest and most varied city park in the world. Covering 840 hectares (2,100 acres) of the city, the park includes areas of greenery, a zoo, gardens, lakes, museums, playgrounds, bridle paths and monuments.

Within a 10-minute walk of the Hotel

Angel de la Independencia (Angel of Independence):

- Angel of Independence is a 45-metre (150-foot) column, surmounted by a winged Victory, constructed between 1901 and 1910 to commemorate the first century of Mexico's independence from Spain.

Within a 15-minute walk of the Hotel

National Museum of Anthropology and History:

- The National Museum of Anthropology and History is one of the world's finest museums. Radiating from the main patio are 12 exhibition halls devoted to Mexico's early civilizations. Filled with priceless relics, such as a 30-ton Aztec stone calendar and life-size replicas of Monte Alban, the museum features the cultures of the Maya, Toltec, Zapotec and Aztec Indians and cultures from the Gulf of Mexico.

Museo Nacional de Historia (National Museum of History):

- The National Museum of History is housed in a building in the Castillo de Chapultepec dating from the 18th century. The former residence of Emperor

Maximilian and Empress Carlota, it contains furniture, weapons and paintings dating from the conquest to the Revolution.

Within a 15-minute drive of the Hotel

Museo del Palacio de Bellas Artes (Fine Arts Palace):

- Museo del Palacio de Bellas Artes houses murals painted by Rivera, Orozco and Siqueiros. It hosts national and international exhibitions.

Ballet Folklórico de México (Folkloric Ballet of Mexico) :

- A spectacular presentation of traditional music, dance and costumes from all corners of the country at the Palace of Fine Arts. Performances vary, depending on the season.

Within a 30-minute drive of the Hotel

Museo del Templo Mayor (The Great Temple of the Aztecs):

- The Great Temple of the Aztecs (Templo Mayor) was discovered in 1978 during the construction of the subway. The 60-metre-high (200-foot) temple served as the religious and political centre of the Aztec empire. The Museo del Templo Mayor houses 7,000 items that were recovered from the temple, including a large-scale model of the sacred centre of the Aztec capital, Tenochtitlan.

Museo Nacional de Arte (National Museum of Art):

- The National Museum of Art is housed in a magnificent building from the early 20th century and showcases Mexican art from the early 15th century to the 1950s.

Museo de San Idelfonso (San Idelfonso Museum):

- The San Idelfonso Museum is in an 18th-century building and displays the early murals of such artists as Orozco, Rivera, Siqueiros, Charlot, Leal, Revueltas and Alva de Canal.

Catedral (National Cathedral):

- National Cathedral is a richly ornamented edifice which contains marble altars, statuary, silver railings and priceless tapestries.

San Angel, Coyoacán and Xochimilco:

- The southern part of the city includes San Angel, Coyoacán and Xochimilco, which are well preserved examples of colonial-style towns. San Angel is the site of the Bazar del Sábado (Saturday Bazaar), one of the most typical craft-markets. Xochimilco is best known for its floating gardens, living examples of the pre-Hispanic agricultural system. Coyoacán is a 45 minute drive from the Hotel and Xochimilco is a one hour drive.

Within a 1-hour drive of the Hotel

Museo Dolores Olmedo (Dolores Olmedo Museum):

- Dolores Olmedo Museum has the most representative collection of works by Diego Rivera and Frida Kahlo displayed in a beautiful, rambling estate-turned-museum.

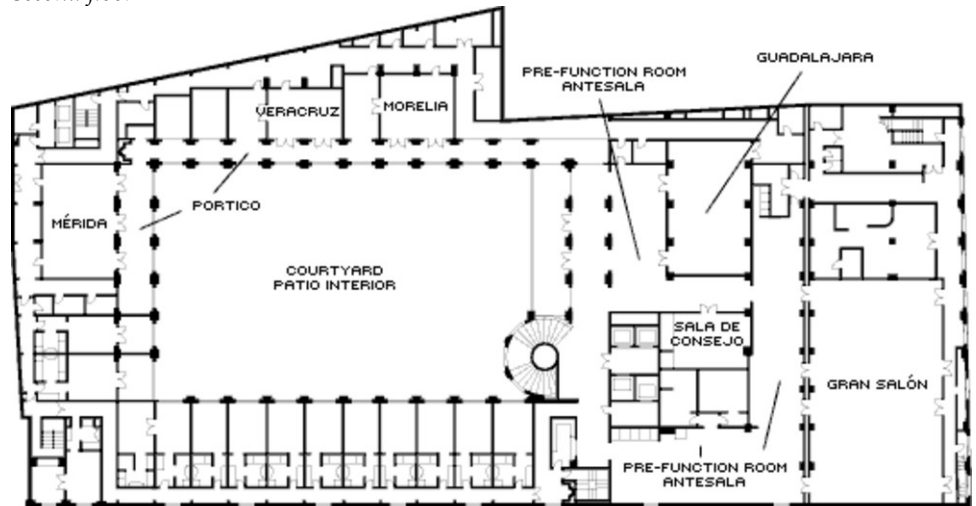
CONFERENCE FACILITIES

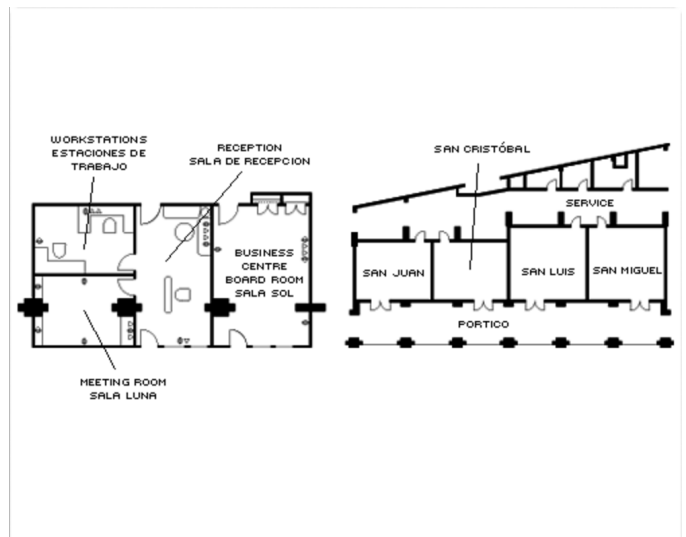

GUEST ROOMS, SUITES AND PRIVATE RESIDENCES OVERVIEW

Guest Room Overview

Guest room choices begin with generously proportioned Superior Rooms with enhanced views of the city from the Hotel's upper floors, while more spacious Deluxe Rooms face the peaceful fountain courtyard. Premier Rooms step out onto the second-floor colonnade overlooking the courtyard, and larger Premier Terrace Rooms offer a private balcony. In the Courtyard, Reforma and Burdeos Four Seasons Executive Suites, named for their views, French doors seclude the sleeping quarters from the living room for greater privacy.

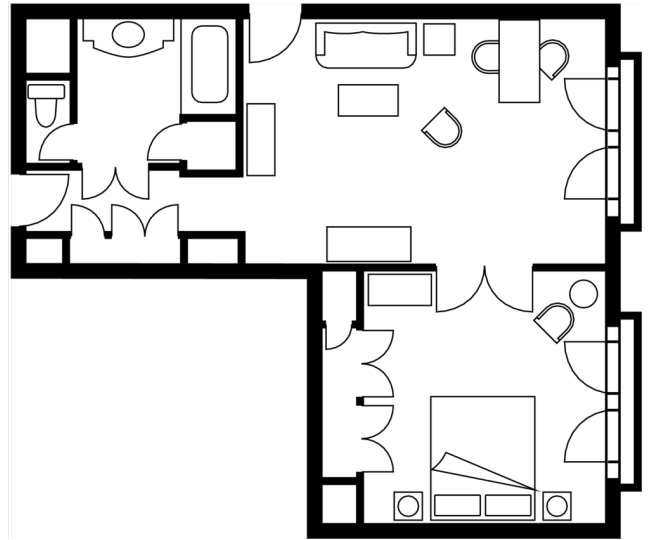
Suites Overview

One-Bedroom Suites offer beautiful views of the courtyard from the second-floor colonnade or from the Hotel's upper floors. On the Hotel's topmost floor, one-bedroom Master Suites welcome guests with their blend of ornate antique with contemporary urbane; the Jardin overlooks the courtyard, while the slightly larger Reforma offers views of the city's main avenue. The Presidential Suite accents contemporary elegance and Mexican antiques with flooring of black granite, dark walnut timber and hand-woven carpets. A gold-leafed screen separates the living and dining areas.

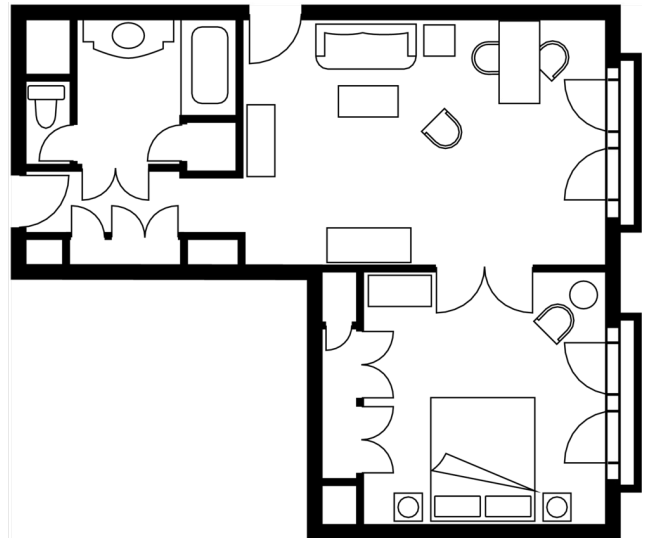
