In a serene, secret corner of Provence – remarkably close to the Côte d'Azur – Four Seasons presents a self-contained suites-only hideaway. With two year-round golf courses and one of Europe's most beautiful spas, it's a world infused with renowned Four Seasons savoir-faire.

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AIRPORTS

- Nice Côte d'Azur International Airport (NCE): 45 to 60 minutes, depending on traffic (56 kilometres/35 miles)
- Cannes-Mandelieu Airport (CEQ): 30 to 45 minutes, depending on traffic (30 kilometres/19 miles)

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Four Seasons Resort Provence at Terre Blanche lies within the Domaine de Terre Blanche, a secluded enclave just outside the village of Fayence. Echoing the design of a tranquil hilltop village, the Resort crowns a wooded summit and features a collection of one- and two-storey villas cascading down the hillside. The buildings are connected by meandering walkways and embraced by fragrant Provençal gardens. Heart-stopping vistas extend over forested hills and medieval villages to the rocky peaks of the Alps in the distance.

All designed as suites – with separate living room and bedroom areas – the Resort's 114 executive suites and villas build upon the region's artistic traditions. Bright contemporary design influences all of the interiors to create a gloriously light-filled ambience.

Five evocative restaurants and lounges celebrate the simple, vivid flavours of Provençal cuisine. Unforgettable gatherings take shape in 650 square metres (6,997 square feet) of versatile function space. Beyond the outdoor swimming pool and fitness centre, two 18-

hole golf courses are enhanced by an expansive spa, acclaimed as one of Europe's most beautiful. Here, in this soothing Resort hideaway, life flows with natural sophistication, smoothed with thoughtful Four Seasons finesse.

TRANSPORTATION

Airports

Nice Côte d'Azur International Airport is France's second largest airport and offers direct flights to many destinations in Europe and the Middle East, as well as direct flights to and from New York City. Cannes-Mandelieu Airport is also available for the exclusive use of private jets.

Train stations

Cannes and Saint Raphaël-Valescure train stations offer daily direct trains to Paris and most European cities. Nice Ville is also available, and is especially good for passengers travelling to or from Italy.

DESTINATION

One of Europe's most storied and sought-after destinations, Provence is a region in southeast France that stretches along 300 kilometres (186 miles) of the Mediterranean coast, reaching up to the mountains of the Alps. Long favoured by artists and writers for its golden sunshine and luminous natural beauty, the landscape presents enchanting broom-covered hills topped with picturesque villages, fields of lavender and mimosa, groves of olive trees and vineyards that stretch forever. Four Seasons presents Provence at its most picturesque, in a world brimming with wineries, flower markets, olive festivals and antique shops.

While nestled within Provence, Four Seasons also offers easy access to the glamorous Côte d'Azur. It's just 30 minutes to the beaches of Cannes, and just 45 minutes to the urban sophistication of Nice. It's also within a comfortable day trip of Aix-en-Provence, the Luberon, the Gorges du Verdon and the Isola 2000 ski resort. This astonishingly convenient location places a diverse realm of experiences at the doorstep of Four Seasons Resort Provence.

WEATHER

The Mediterranean coast has the driest climate in France. Provence averages 300 days of sunshine annually. Most rain falls in spring and autumn. Summers are comfortably dry.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS AND ACTIVITIES

At Four Seasons, you enjoy a unique vantage point from which to explore the sights, sounds and experiences around you. We hope the highlights of local attractions below help simplify your planning. Please let us know how else we can assist you.

Within a 15-minute drive of the Resort

Tourrettes:

- Close to Fayence, Tourrettes is another fortified village backed by a range of hills. It nestles at the foot of the imposing Château du Puy – a castle built by one of Napoleon's generals – and is backed by a range of hills.

Fayence:

- The closest of several old and fortified villages in the area, Fayence is known for its steep, winding streets lined with attractive shops, restaurants and cafés. It offers a farmer's market that is open in the mornings, three times a week, year-round. It is also well known in Europe for its gliding centre.

Within a 30-minute drive of the Resort

Picasso Museum:

- The 16th-century Chateau Grimaldi was converted into a museum in 1928. In 1946, Picasso used the chateau as his base, and he later donated all of the works he had produced there to what is now known as the Picasso Museum. A permanent collection on the museum's terrace features a remarkable collection of modern sculptures including works by Germaine Richier and Miro. The museum is located in Antibes, which lies between Nice and Cannes.

Cannes:

- Originally a small fishing village that was “discovered” in the 1830s, and ultimately became the preferred vacation spot amongst the international elite. The International Film Festival of Cannes in May is a must on the film world’s calendar, and year-round it offers superb dining and shopping, and delightful strolls along the famed Boulevard de la Croisette.

Grasse:

- This hill town is known as the perfume capital of the world. The 3,000-year-old history of perfume is traced in the International Museum of Perfumes, which includes an exquisite display of perfume bottles used in the ancient worlds of the Orient, Greece, Rome and Egypt.

Seillans:

- This medieval village seems to have jumped out of the Middle Ages and is considered one of the loveliest in France; it is home to many artists and its Notre-Dame de L’Ormeau church is an architectural jewel that is well worth visiting.

Mougins:

- Another lovely medieval village that nestles amongst pine, olive and cypress trees, and has been a popular haunt with legions of artists over the years.

Lac de St. Cassien:

- This 43-hectare (106-acre) nature reserve is popular for bird watching, fishing and water sports.

Within a 1-hour drive of the Resort

St. Paul de Vence:

- High on a hillside, St. Paul-de-Vence has attracted some of Europe’s most exciting artists; its hilly and winding alleys are full of art galleries and craft shops. Fondation Maeght houses one of the finest collections of modern art in Europe, including works by Bonnard, Braque, Kandinsky and Matisse. In the summer it hosts concerts and art film screenings.

Nice:

- Nice is the main gateway to Provence, and the centre of many activities, including dining, shopping, sunbathing and swimming, movies, theatre, opera, museums – or just strolling along the 7-kilometre (4-mile) Promenade des Anglais, or around its charming “old town”.

Matisse Museum:

- The Matisse Museum in Cimiez, the old Roman section of Nice, is housed in a large 17th-century Genoese villa set in an olive grove. The museum has the world’s largest collection of works by Matisse.

Marc Chagall Museum:

- In the hills of Cimiez, above Nice, the Marc Chagall Museum is a comprehensive collection of his paintings, stained glass windows and a mosaic he created especially for the building. The collection is dedicated to the artist’s treatment of biblical themes.

Renoir Museum:

- Auguste Renoir lived in Cagnes-sur-Mer, a small fishing port and seaside resort, from 1907 to 1919. His house has been converted into the Renoir Museum, with the studio kept just as it was at the time of the artist's death. The garden is full of hundred-year-old olive trees, orange trees and wild flowers.

Within a 1.5-hour drive of the Resort

St. Tropez:

- Otherwise known as “St. Trop”, this resort town has long been a favourite of the international jet set, for its parties as much as its beaches. Despite the glitz, the old town centre retains much of its Provençal fishing-port charm.

Monaco:

- This tiny principality sits on a 450-acre (18-hectare) rock peninsula. The old town of Monaco features the Prince's Palace, the outstanding Oceanographic Museum and Aquarium and the panoramic Place du Palais. Monte Carlo is the crown of the principality, with high-rolling casinos, exclusive shops and a dynamic nightlife.

Gorges du Verdon:

- In the Alps, the 21-kilometre (13-mile)-long Gorges du Verdon is considered the Grand Canyon of France. At its north end, the town of Moustiers-Ste-Marie is famous for its faïence ceramics. The area is popular for rafting, canoeing and kayaking on the River Verdun, and for climbing, hiking, horseback riding and mountain biking.

Eze:

- This medieval village sits on a narrow rocky peak, with exceptionally panoramic views over the Mediterranean, as far as St. Tropez. A popular tourist spot, with plenty of shopping opportunities. The ancient fortified village is crowned with the ruins of a 12th-century castle, which has a cactus garden in its grounds.

San Remo:

- On the Italian Riviera, San Remo is a lively flower-filled resort, much favoured amongst European nobility. It boasts the Riviera's most famous casino after Monte Carlo, a racetrack, 18-hole golf course and miles of well-maintained beaches.

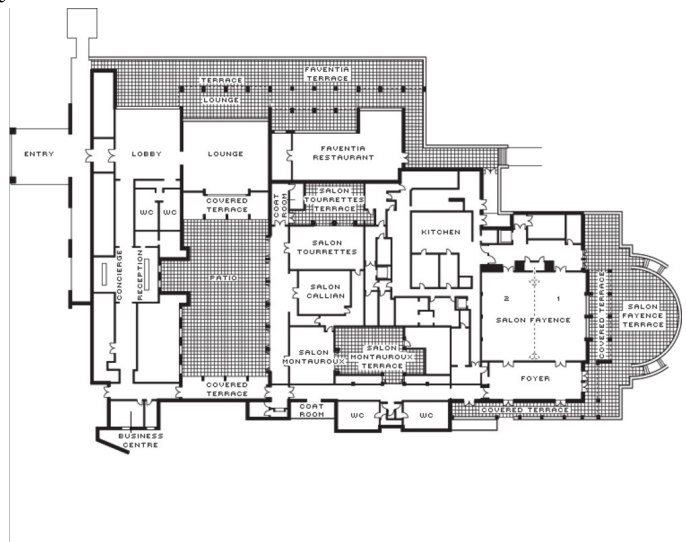
CONFERENCE FACILITIES

An inspiring venue for groups of up to 280 people, Four Seasons Resort Provence at Terre Blanche features 650 square metres (6,997 square feet) of banquet and meeting space. The setting combines the heritage of Provence and the focus of a self-contained resort with exemplary service and the most up-to-date technology.

Located within the main building, the Salon Fayence ballroom is divisible in two and can accommodate up to 220 for a banquet or 280 for a reception. Its pre-function area opens onto a terrace with views to the villages of Callian and Montauroux. A variety of smaller meeting rooms offer flexibility for board meetings, seminars and conferences. All are equipped with technological support such as high-speed Internet access and automated blackout curtains. Most rooms open onto adjacent outdoor terraces or private lawns.

The Resort's many outdoor terraces are magical for social and corporate events, including garden parties. The pool terrace includes a permanent barbecue and dramatic night-time lighting.

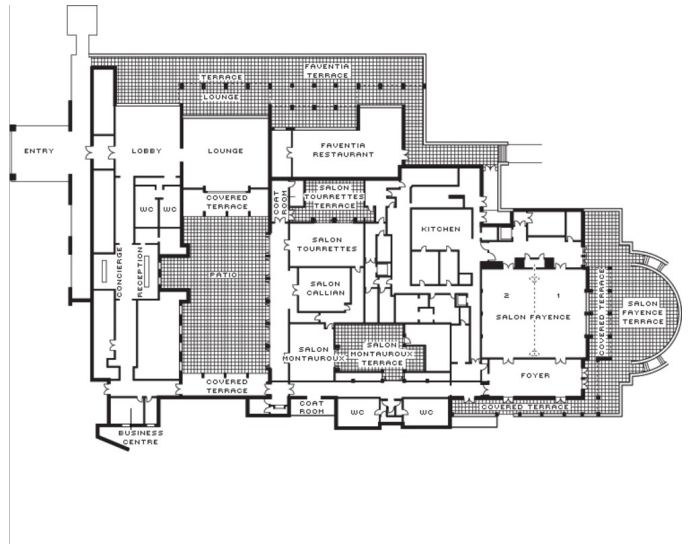


SALON FAYENCE TERRACE

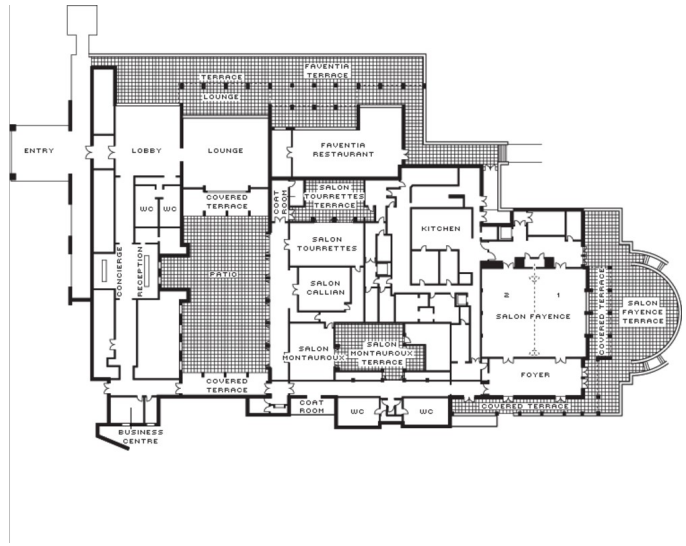


SALON TOURRETTES TERRACE

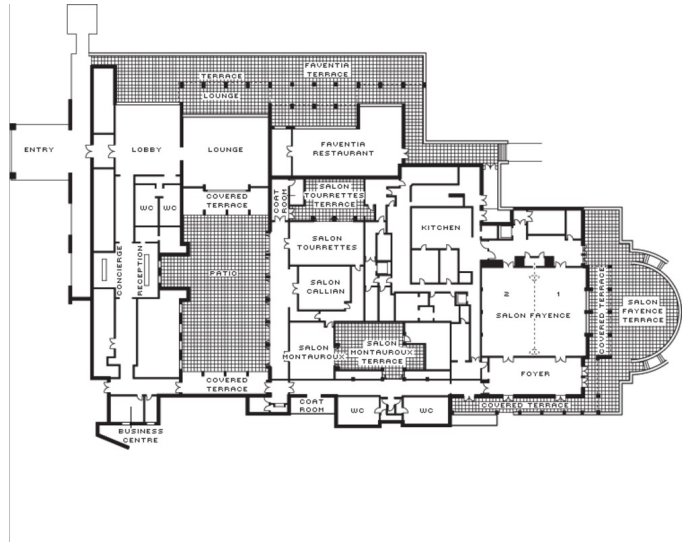


SALON MONTAUX TERRACE

GUEST ROOMS, SUITES AND PRIVATE RESIDENCES OVERVIEW

All 114 Four Seasons accommodations are self-contained executive suites and free-standing villas, set within a series of intimate one- and two-storey buildings spilling down the hillside. Bright and airy interiors feature a separate living room and bedroom, with French doors that open onto a private balcony or terrace. Enchanting views reach over the valley to the mountains and the nearby villages of Fayence and Tourrettes.

Evocative décor includes natural wood and stone finishes and a palette inspired by sunshine and flowers. Sleekly designed furnishings, rattan chairs, bright loose-weave rugs and striking artwork are Provençal in spirit and contemporary in style. Well-defined work areas support productivity with the latest technology for communication, including high-speed Internet access and dual-line telephones, along with an in-room safe suitable for a large laptop computer. For relaxation, there's a fully stocked private bar, a television and a CD entertainment centre in a handsome wall alcove.

Extra-spacious ensuite marble bathrooms include signature Four Seasons features – a deep-soaking tub with separate glass-walled shower, a large double vanity, and a WC with telephone in a separate alcove. Colourful Provençal tiles add charm, and in many of the bathrooms, daylight flows through a large picture window.

Guest Room Overview

Superior Four Seasons Executive Suites are spacious, airy and elegantly casual, with a sliding door separating the bedroom from the living room. French doors from both the living room and master bedroom lead to a large ground-floor outdoor terrace with views over the valley. Similar in design, Deluxe Four Seasons Executive Suites offer ground-floor terraces with enhanced privacy and views over the valley or the mountains and villages beyond. On the ground and first floors, Premier Four Seasons Executive Suites present even more expansive views, some including the golf courses.

Suites Overview

Villas at Four Seasons Resort Provence are designed as free-standing homes and provide outstanding privacy and relaxation. Deluxe One-Bedroom Villas include a large living room with a dining area for casual meals and entertaining; a small powder room leads off the living room. Views from the ground-floor terrace look over the valley to the mountains and villages beyond; some encompass views of the golf courses. Premier One-Bedroom Villas are similar in design, while the ground-floor terraces provide enhanced privacy.

With two bedrooms, Villa Estérel and Villa Provence both offer an extra-spacious living room (with adjacent powder room) and two dining areas: one indoors, the other outside on the terrace – where guests may also relax in a secluded whirlpool. High on the hillside, the premier three-bedroom Villa Terre Blanche offers dazzling views over the valley and the nearby villages. Guests may relax or entertain in the comfortable living room, on the spectacular terrace or in the library, complete with its own television and private bar. The villa's kitchen facilitates catering and service to the indoor and outdoor dining areas – each of which accommodate up to eight people. A swimming pool and whirlpool are exclusively for the use of the villa's guests.

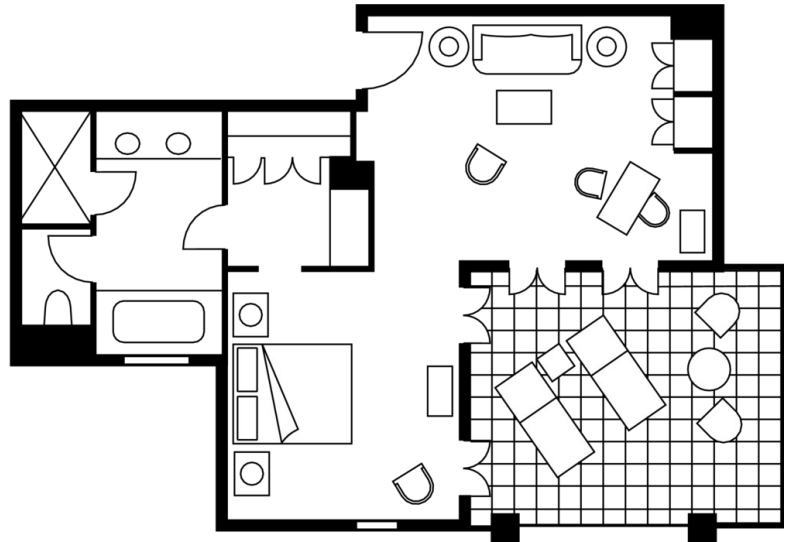

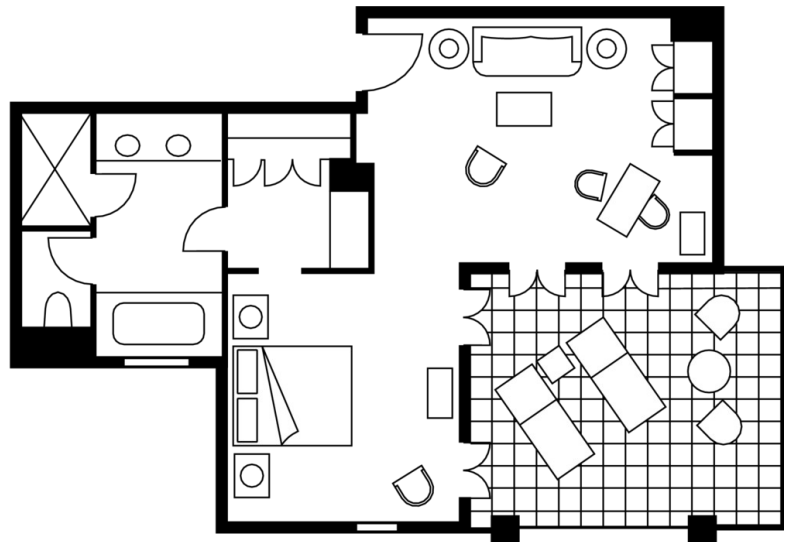

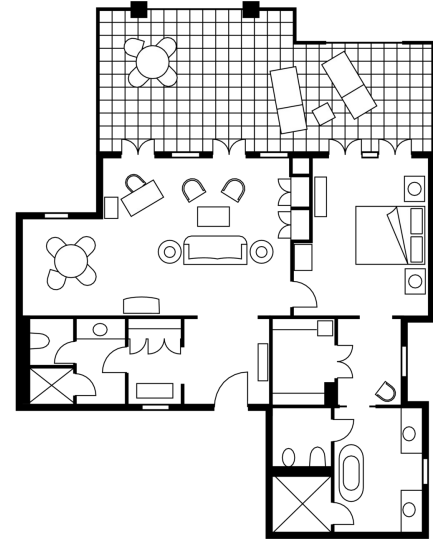

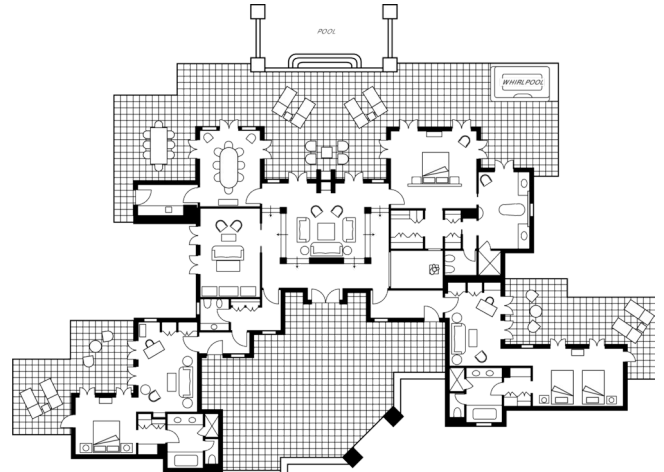

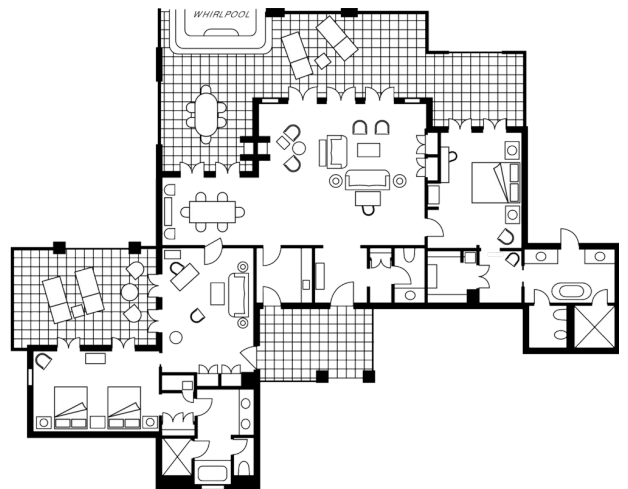
