

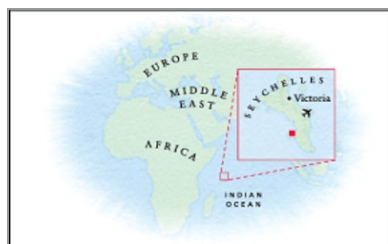

In this lush castaway sanctuary – lost in the Indian Ocean – brilliantly green coastline reveals tree-house villas perched amidst granite boulders. Days promise barefoot ease strolling the powder-sand beach – considered one of the island’s best. Nature’s richness recharges the spirit with storybook adventure in jungle and sea.



Located on the archipelago’s main island of Mahé, Four Seasons Resort Seychelles is quietly secluded on the southwest coast – just 30 minutes from the international airport and the capital, Victoria. Laced across a steep hillside with granite outcroppings and dense jungle, the Resort covers an expanse of 69 hectares (170 acres), set around the horseshoe-shaped bay of Petite Anse. Black granite boulders line the powder-white beach – in bold contrast to the azure-blue sea.

Four Seasons offers the intimacy of just 67 villas – including five suites – each with veranda and plunge pool. The air is filled with tropical birdsong and scented by cinnamon trees and frangipani.

Dining and cocktails are offered at two restaurants and two lounges, set hillside and beachside. For special gatherings, there is 233 square metres (2,508 square feet) of

function space for up to 150 guests. Event settings include an outdoor bay-view terrace, gardens and beaches. High above the bay, the hilltop spa epitomises the Resort's sense of tranquillity and seclusion. Recreation ranges from yoga classes to water sports on the Resort's own beach. Multilingual concierge staff help guests connect to the culture and people of Seychelles, accessing the highest quality excursions and experiences. Setting a new standard for service in the Seychelles, Four Seasons brings a warm, friendly attitude and dedicated guest support.

TRANSPORTATION

Direct or connecting flights to Seychelles International Airport (SEZ) are available from many international destinations, including Australia, France, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Kenya, Mauritius, Singapore, South Africa, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom and Thailand. Airlines serving the airport include Air Seychelles, Emirates Air, Qatar Airways, Kenya Airways, Air France, Air Austral and Condor.

DESTINATION

A tropical paradise of pristine beaches and magnificent natural wonders, the Seychelles inspire a sense of castaway seclusion and adventure. Located near the East African coast, just north of Madagascar, the Seychelles form an archipelago of 115 islands scattered across the Indian Ocean. First settled by the French in 1770, the islands still feel undiscovered, and only about 20 are inhabited. The Seychelles have no indigenous population, and today they display a vibrant ethnic diversity – with the largest groups being of French, African, Indian and Chinese descent. A strong French Creole influence is evident in culture, custom and cuisine. The official languages are French and English, along with Seychellois Creole.

Protected land- and seascapes are home to unique-on-the-planet plant and marine life – with more than 1,000 recorded species of fish, a massive seabird colony and the largest population of giant tortoises outside the Galapagos. Thrilling water sports and jungle exploration give a sense of Robinson Crusoe-style adventure and discovery. Of special note, the time zone of the Seychelles is just four hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time – causing minimal jet lag when arriving from European and Asian cities.

WEATHER

Seychelles boasts an enviable climate that is always warm and without extremes – creating an ideal year-round destination. Its tropical climate is influenced by the ocean. The hot season is from October to April and the cool season is from May to September.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS AND ACTIVITIES

At Four Seasons, you enjoy a unique vantage point from which to explore the sights, sounds and experiences around you. We hope the highlights of local attractions below help simplify your planning. Please let us know how else we can assist you.

Within a 10-minute drive of the Resort

Michael Adams Gallery:

- Experience the richness of local folklore through the art of Michael Adams. Some of his work is also displayed in the Resort's reception area and throughout the villas and suites.

Within a 15-minute drive of the Resort

Le Jardin du Roi (Royal Garden):

- Take a tour of these magnificent gardens, and learn about spice cultivation in Seychelles and the flora and fauna indigenous to the islands.

Within a 20-minute drive of the Resort

Diving at Takamaka Bay :

- Explore the underwater granite structure beneath Seychelles. Takamaka Rocks is the one of closest diving points to the Resort.

Within a 30-minute drive of the Resort

Mont Fleuri Botanical Gardens :

- Established in 1901, the Botanical Gardens feature a collection of palms native to Seychelles, including the coco de mer, as well as a tortoise park and a rainforest walk.

Victoria Market:

- Enjoy a visit to the vibrant and bustling Victoria Market, where you will see everything from local crafts made from coconut to silk paintings and handmade jewellery. Fishermen bring their catch to the fish market, and stalls sell fragrant spices, citronella tea and local delicacies.

Antik Kolony:

- Antik Kolony in Victoria offers a colourful selection of hand-painted scarves, *pareo*, bags and gifts.

Kenwyn House/Francis Rachel Street:

- Located in the town of Victoria, Kenwyn House and Francis Rachel Street are the perfect places to find paintings and works of art, jewellery from South Africa and high-end resort fashions and gifts.

Natural History Museum:

- Located in Victoria, this museum provides a glimpse of the history of Seychelles.

Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception:

- This French-colonial-style Roman Catholic church was built in 1874 and is located in the town of Victoria. It is the centre of religious life for much of the population of Seychelles and features a small garden with a graceful statue of the Virgin Mary.

Within a 15-minute plane ride of the Resort

Vallée de Mai:

- A 15-minute flight to the island of Praslin will bring you to the Vallée de Mai, an UNESCO World Heritage Site. This virgin palm forest is 650 million years old, and offers a chance to see the majestic coco de mer.

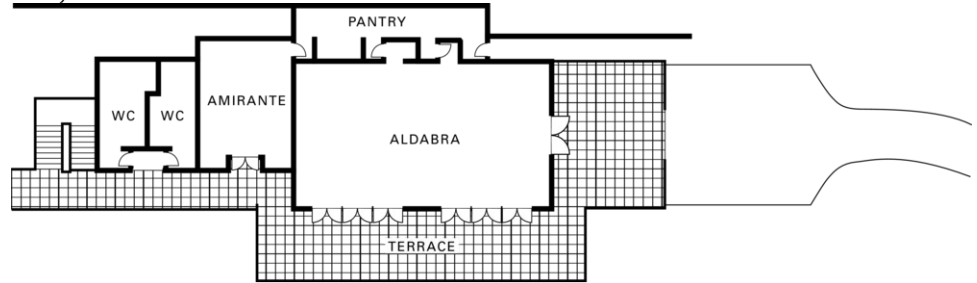

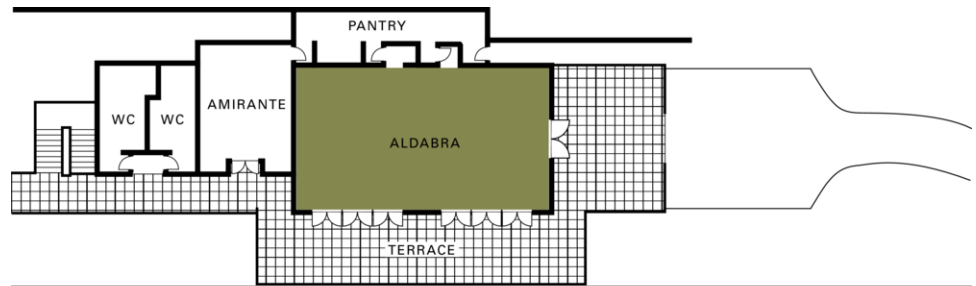

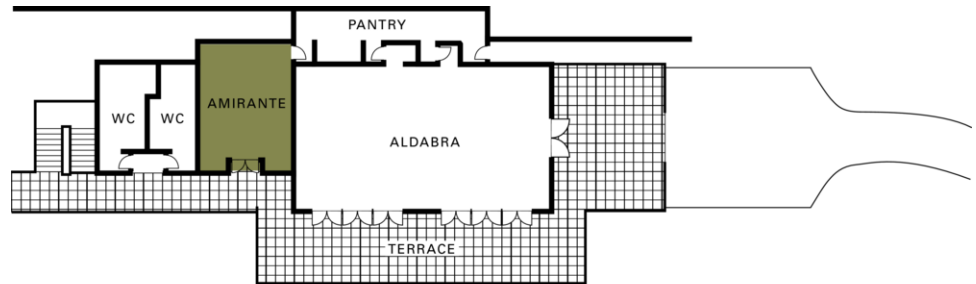

GUEST ROOMS, SUITES AND PRIVATE RESIDENCES OVERVIEW

Offering solitude and serenity, each of Four Seasons Resort Seychelles's 67 villas – including five suites – offers a private sanctuary, perched on stilts high on the jungle hillside or nestled amidst greenery close to the beach. Views look toward the azure waters of the Indian Ocean.

With more living area outdoors than indoors, these expansive accommodations are designed in traditional Creole style, featuring natural timber and brick. Many incorporate existing granite boulders into their sleek, airy interiors. Each villa is surrounded by a large hardwood deck. The highlight is an infinity-edge plunge pool, edged by comfortable chaises longues and a marble dining table. A shaded daybed is perfect for an al fresco massage, a fan-cooled afternoon siesta or lounging to watch the sun set over the sea.

Facing onto the deck, the air-conditioned bedroom and sitting areas exude simple Creole elegance, featuring tropical rosewood and silk prints. Amenities include a 107-centimetre (42-inch) flat-screen television, a CD/DVD player, as well as wireless Internet access. Sunny and open, the hugely spacious bathroom features a deep soaking tub set beside a window overlooking the plunge pool and ocean. In addition to the glass-walled indoor rain shower, there's an outdoor shower, open to sky and sea yet completely discreet. Twin vanities are joined by a private WC with bidet and a walk-in closet/dressing area.

Guest Room Overview

Spread across the Resort's granite terrain, the villas of Four Seasons exude the comfort and charm of private homes. Garden-View Villas are the most suitable choice for families with children. These villas are just steps from the shoreline and feature stunning views of the island's lush tropical surroundings. Slightly higher on the hillside and just a short walk

from the shoreline, Ocean-View Villas offer beautiful views of the Indian Ocean. From high above Petite Anse bay, Hilltop Ocean-View Villas feature unforgettable panoramic views of the turquoise and blue waters of the bay and the surrounding mountains.

Suites Overview

With greater space and flexibility, the Resort's suites offer up to three bedrooms and even more expansive outdoor living areas. Suites are composed of a collection of pavilions. A separate two-storey pavilion houses interior living space, a dining area and a pantry with a separate service entrance. For added privacy, bedrooms are in separate pavilions, each with ensuite bathroom, connected via the exterior deck. Suites also include complimentary poolside afternoon cocktails and butler service upon request.

The Two-Bedroom Ocean-View Suite offers panoramic views of the Indian Ocean, just a short walk from the shoreline, while the Two-Bedroom Hilltop Ocean-View Suites are perched high above Petite Anse bay, enjoying panoramic views of the bay and the surrounding mountains. The Two-Bedroom Presidential Suite and the Three-Bedroom Royal Suite both enjoy premier views of the Indian Ocean, just steps from the shoreline.

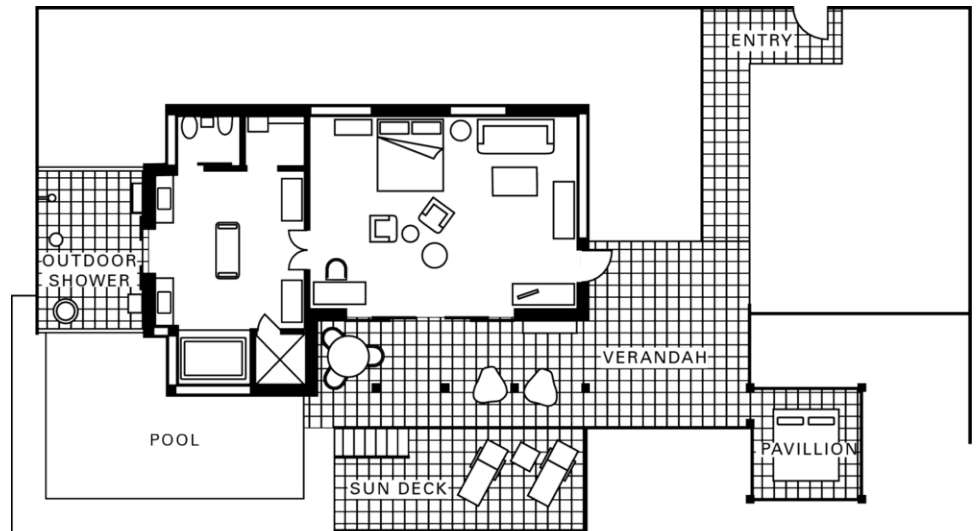

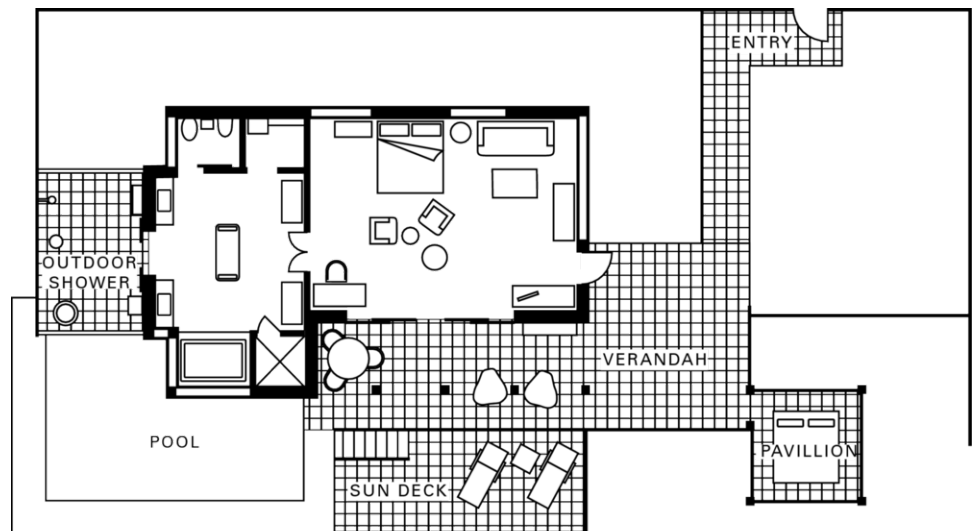

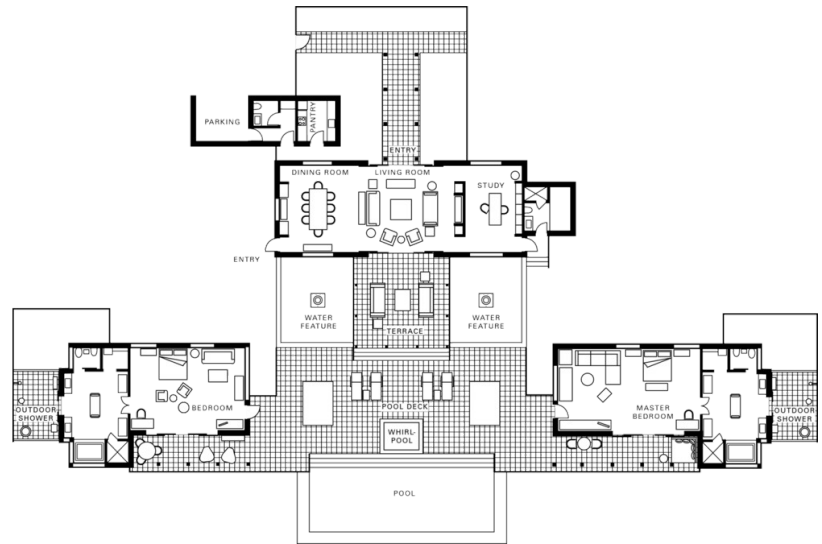

RECREATION FACILITIES

Recreation abounds at Four Seasons Resort Seychelles – from the outdoor swimming pool and water sports pavilion to the fitness centre, library and art gallery. Land and sea activities are available for both the adventurous and the leisure-minded – with every detail coordinated by the multilingual Four Seasons concierge staff. Time here promises to reawaken the thrill of new discovery.

SPA SERVICES

Located at the top of the hill, with spectacular views of Petite Anse and the entire Resort, the Spa is designed with a focus on solitude and seclusion. Five individual spa pavilions offer beautiful views of the Indian Ocean.

A 54-square-metre (580-square-foot) yoga pavilion is connected to the Spa entrance by a timber deck. The space is available from sunrise to sunset for private instruction or individual yoga sessions. Yoga mats, straps, blocks, towels and water are provided.

Joggers looking for a moderate course can take advantage of the Resort's jogging trail around the lagoon and through the garden at the foothills of the mountain backdrop surrounding Petite Anse.

An advanced trail, more suitable for a comfortably paced walk, offers steep elevation

changes and some of the most impressive views of the Resort.

The routes range from 3 to 6 kilometres (2 to 4 miles).

Library

The Library is set in its own 56-square-metre (600-square-foot) pavilion, where guests can lounge with a collection of contemporary books and magazines, including guidebooks about Seychelles and Creole culture. 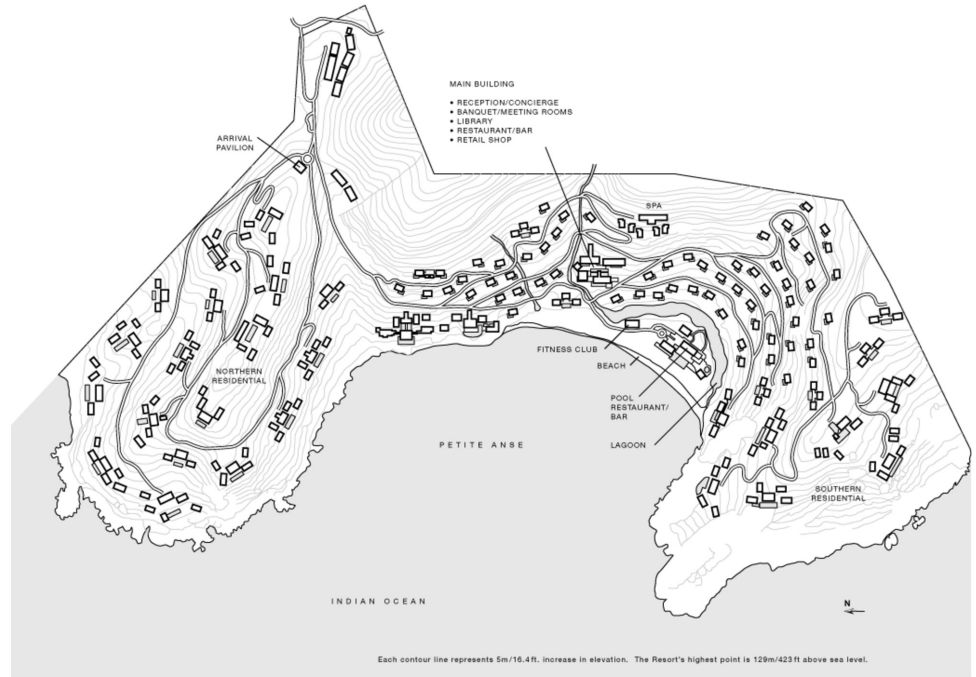
